The docket was adjusted from a two-day meeting to one day.

110-01 CALL TO ORDER by Moderator TE Bryant Harris at 11:00 AM

110-02 WELCOME & WORSHIP – The Moderator welcomed commissioners to Presbytery and called the meeting to order and prayed.

TE Eric Geil provided a Call to Worship with a reading from the Psalms and Wayne Wilson of ChristChurch sang “Lift High the Cross”. The Moderator introduced Candidate Daniel Cheevers, who was to be examined as the new Pastor of Bethany Church, Kingsport, Tennessee and prayed for Daniel as he came to preach. Daniel’s text was Psalm 46. At the close of his sermon, he led the Presbytery in prayer.

ADDENDUM 2

REPORT - CHURCH HEALTH AND GROWTH COMMITTEE

- Committee members have been in contact with a Pastor, the Clerk of Session or a key leader of our churches during these days of the COVID-19 virus and it's interruption to lives, livelihoods and typical church functions including worship. We have attempted to provide encouragement to the contact person in each church. Every church in the presbytery is prayed for regularly.

- Committee members tuned into worship services through electronic means during these weeks that church buildings have been closed and services have been conducted in alternative ways.

It is amazing the efforts that have been made to reach into homes with worship services, devotions and Bible studies through various electronic platforms or whatever works best for the members of the church. In one church the pastor emails his sermon script with two hymns with lyrics to households with known email addresses. In the case of members that do not have electronic capability this pastor US Mails a paper copy each week to these homes. Between these two efforts each church member's home is reached each week.

A typical comment from pastors is that it is difficult to preach to an empty sanctuary or in an empty study space. The preacher cannot gauge responses to the sermon from congregation members that sit in predictable locations in the sanctuary exhibiting their predictable body language.

Another typical comment is that the uses of electronic media will bring changes to the method that an individual church might worship and broadcast services in the future.

- The efforts of individuals and churches that have assisted in the Easter Sunday tornado disaster areas in SE Tennessee and NW Georgia has been significant and is greatly appreciated. A Saturday workday was held on Saturday, May 9th in the Brainerd area that included members of Brainerd Church (Chattanooga), Valleybrook (Chattanooga), Signal Mountain and ChristChurch (Dalton). New Life Gathering (Knoxville) worked tornado relief in the Ooltewah area. First Pres (Rome), Resurrection (Chattanooga) and ChristChurch provided assistance and support in NW Georgia. TE Joey Sherrard (SMPC) has coordinated this relief ministry. Also, our thanks to TE Chris Robinson who provided extensive expertise through the non-profit he directs, Project 52.

- In this time of economic difficulty financial contributions to some churches has unfortunately decreased. Loss of jobs, loss of personal income and churches not physically meeting for 8-10 weeks have added to this drop in financial contributions.

We might suggest that a direct mailing be sent to church members stating financial facts and status of the church budget. This committee can provide a one-time grant to help to finance a direct mailing if a grant form is completed. This could

be \$50, \$100, or \$150 to help defray the costs to duplicate a letter, buy and stuff an envelope and affix postage on the outside envelope. Research has proven that if a pre-addressed envelope with the church or treasurer's address has been pre-printed and provided then the giver is more likely to respond with a contribution enclosed.

Our committee is not in a position to pay salaries, utilities and other costs of church operation.

- The Session and Pastor of New Hope Church in Kingsport, Tennessee applied for a grant to assist with paying fees associated with the GO Center for a church revitalization project. Dr. Ken Priddy will provide services and consultations to New Hope. This church has also raised support from within the church and applied for assistance from the General Assembly office.

The Church Health and Growth Committee is pleased to support this effort and fund this request with a \$2,500 grant from the Church Development Fund of the Presbytery.
